

Storage Tank Operator Training and Certification

The Division of Oil and Public Safety (OPS) maximizes protection of public health and the environment from contamination caused by leaking petroleum storage tanks and prevention of releases from all regulated storage tanks.

The training of operators of underground storage tanks is regulated by this division. The deadline for training and certification of operators of underground storage tanks is fast approaching.

Chose the “oil inspection section” than “operator training” which will lead to the “certification and approval” page for the contact information. One person in each county with this certification will satisfy the regulations promulgated by the Oil and Public Safety department in response to the Energy Policy Act requirements.

What This Means For Counties

Underground storage tank owners, January 1, 2010 is the target for owner/operators to provide proof to the division of oil and public safety that they have acquired the Class A, B or C operators certification.
