New Employer's First Report of Injury form required to report workers' compensation injuries

The Colorado Division of Workers' Compensation has revised the Employer's First Report of Injury form. Effective January 1, 2004, all employers in Colorado are required to use the new form to alert the Division of workers compensation injuries. The new form must be used immediately for any future filings.

A copy of the new form is attached to this Technical Update. The form can also be accessed on the Colorado Division of Workers' Compensation website at <http://www.coworkforce.com/DWC> in three formats: MS Word, PDF Printable and PDF Fillable.

The Colorado Division of Workers' Compensation will not process injuries reported on the incorrect form. Any county that submits information on the old form will be asked to resubmit the information using the newly revised form dated 1/04.

Please notify all individuals who report injuries and illnesses about this change. Also, discard any Employer's First Report of Injury forms dated prior to January 1, 2004.
