

Updated List Of Alcohol Screening Devices

The list of approved alcohol screening devices has been updated by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). Changes to the list were last published on May 4, 2001. Since then, NHTSA has evaluated additional devices, resulting in the changes shown in the accompanying tables.
