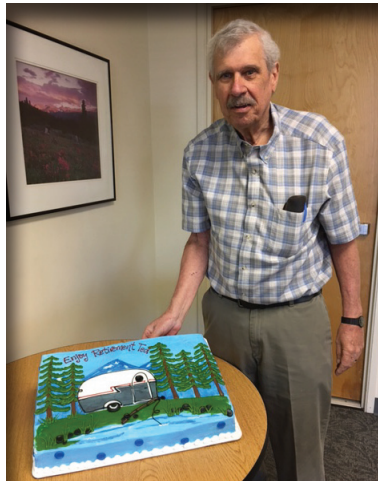


A Farewell and A Welcome at CTSI
