
CTSI Film Library

CTSI maintains a large film library of training materials for its members. The library contains hundreds of films on numerous topics such as ADA and Disability Law and Supervising the Drug Free Workplace. Film formats are a mix of VHS, DVD, or online videos. These films are a benefit to CTSI members allowing you to supplement your staff training plans.

Online Video Library

Online films can be accessed at ctsifilms.org. You may also access the film library from the CTSI home page by clicking on the blue “Online Video Library” button on the right side of the page. Use of the film site requires you to create a login account. Once the account is created and approved, the films can be viewed online. Please note that you must have Flash enabled to view the films online.

The CTSI Films website gives you the ability to designate certain films as a “favorite.” These films are then saved to a favorite’s list, making them easier to find in the future.

Loss Prevention Film Library

For a full listing of all films available, visit ctsi.org and click on the orange “Loss Prevention Film Library” button on the right of the screen. A PDF of available films is also located at www.ctsi.org/memberscounty/pdf/film_library.pdf. This 28-page PDF divides films into categories and

provides you with the film format, number, and running time. This library also lists films designated as current or archive. Films in the archive category have technically relevant content, but the clothing, scenery, or cultural references are dated.
